## AUSTRALIAN SUNSHINE STATE CLASSIC - BRIEF GUIDELINES

### **Eligibility to Compete**

DFA Grand Prix and BDO Invitational Ranked Event. The Men's and Ladies Singles Grand Prix is only open to players eligible to play in the Winmau World Masters and Lakeside Professional Championships.

### **Format of Play**

The top 16 seeds (Men) and 8 seeds (Ladies) automatically qualify for the main event to be played on Sunday. There will be a 32 player minimum draw in the main event for the men and 16 for the Ladies.

Players qualifying for Sunday's main event will play a Round Robin draw (4 players per board) in the preliminary stage as follows:

### **Men Singles & Ladies Singles**

Preliminary **Best of 7**

Quarter **Best of 9**

Semi-Finals **Best of 11**

Grand Final **Best of 13**

### **Non - Seeded Qualifying Stage**

Each board will be allocated a maximum of four players. Qualifying rounds will be played in a Round Robin format (best of 3 legs). The number of qualifiers per board will be determined by total entries and an announcement made prior to the commencement of play to clarify the number of players from each board qualifying for the main event.

The qualifying round is played on Saturday morning prior to the doubles.

### **Seeding Order**

8 or 16 players will be seeded as follows:

BDO Rankings

WDF Rankings

DFA Rankings

Non-filled positions will be seeded by the Contest Director from the DFA Rankings List.

Please note that the allocation of a seeded position is dependent upon the seeded player competing in the Doubles Events on the Saturday and making themselves available for promotional and/or sponsor opportunities by the host.

## AUSTRALIAN SUNSHINE STATE CLASSIC - BRIEF GUIDELINES

### **Dress Code**

All attire shall conform to the good image of the sport, the minimum standard being:

#### **Men**

- Long Trousers (*strictly no denim*)
- Covered Shoes
- Collared Shirt (*with sleeves*)

#### **Ladies**

- Slacks/Skirt (*Strictly no denim or ¾ pants*)
- Covered Shoes
- Collared Shirt or Blouse (*with sleeves*)

No headwear shall be worn without the prior permission of the DFA nominated tournament organiser or official. Under normal circumstances approval would only be granted for religious or medical reasons.

Where medical reasons necessitate the wearing of attire that does not conform to the above rules, special permission must be obtained from the DFA or its nominated person.

### **Sponsor's Logos and/or other material**

Strictly no conflicting sponsor brands are to be displayed for the duration of the tournament. This includes the Doubles Events.

Conflicting sponsor brands are deemed as any material that advertises a brand/event/organization or entity and includes both equipment and attire. To protect commercial interests this is not restricted to competitors.

### **Right to Refuse Entry**

The organisers of the event reserve the right to refuse entry to any competitor or spectator at their discretion to both the event and the venue.

- 10.00 a.m Start of Singles Qualifying
- 11.30 a.m Doubles Nominations Close
- 1.00 p.m (*at the conclusion of the Singles Qualifying games*) Start of Doubles.

#### **Sunday 24 October 2010**

Singles Commence 10.00 a.m preliminary round robin followed by Knock out rounds.

**A separate singles event will be played for non qualifying players on the Sunday. DFA points will apply to this event.**

### *WDF playing and Tournament Rules*

20.07 –No player, or official, or agent who has participated in any capacity, at any stage in a 'World', 'International' or 'National Titled' event, which is outside the jurisdiction of, and not recognized by the WDF, or any of its Member Darts Bodies, shall be eligible to participate in any WDF darts event, or any WDF Ranked darts event.

9.02 – A WDF member Darts body, or its appointed organizers, shall reserve the right to refuse, or cancel, any entrant, at any stage prior to during, or after a darts event which is within their jurisdiction, and their decision shall be final and binding in all matches relating to that darts event (BY-Law No. 32)

WDF Levy Fee – A\$2 player fees has been included in entry fee. This levy will fund the monetary WDF Rankings Awards, attempts towards Olympic recognition and other WDF benefits and services.

DFA Levy Fee – A\$1 player fee has been included in entry fee. This levy will fund DFA benefits and services.

Note: The DFA policy is that "no player shall be restricted to play any DFA competition, as per our constitution, however it is up to the individual player to know their contractual obligation when they nominate".
