Format

Round robin board draw to final 8 pairs.

(Number of pairs per board will be dependant upon nominations received)

Preliminary (round robin board draw shall be) 601 best of 5.

Knock-out rounds.

Quarter-finals: 601 best of 5 legs.

Semi-finals: 601 best of 7 legs.

Finals: 601 best of 9 legs.

All singles players please note the following.

Directly following the completion of the doubles competition on Saturday afternoon play shall commence in the qualifying rounds of singles.

Played as round robin on boards'. Winner and runner up on each board will go through to meet the sixteen seeds on Sunday 7th February

Number of players per board will be dependant upon nominations received.

Format: Saturday Qualifying Singles.:

Saturdays' preliminary round robin board draw to final 16 for progress to Sundays knock-out

501 best of 5: winner and runner-up on each board to progress to Sunday.

The 16 qualifying players from Saturday shall at the completion of play on Saturday be drawn to compete against the 16 seeded players on Sunday in an open draw 1 to 16.

Seeding will be graded using WDF ranking points/ BDO ranking points/ DFA ranking points.

If insufficient numbers nominate the right is reserved to change the above to suit the numbers participating.

Format: Sunday.

Start of play 09.00am.

Qualifying Round: Board Draw four (4) Players per board best of 3 sets each set 501 best of 3 games: winner of each board to qualify for knock-out quarter-finals.

Knock-out sets.

Quarter-finals Ladies: Best of 3 sets each set 501 best of 3 games.

Quarter-finals Men's: Best of 5 sets each set 501 best of 3 games.

Semi-finals Ladies: Best of 5 sets each set 501 best of 3 games.

Semi-finals Men's: Best of 7 sets each set 501 best of 5 games.

Ladies Final: Best of 5 sets each set 501 best of 5 games.

Men's Final: Best of 9 sets each set 501 best of 5 games.

All prize winners must be present at prize presentation on Sunday 7th February to collect their prize, any player not present shall forfeit the prize monies won and ranking points.
